Competition Byelaws

Music Section

1. Entries will not be accepted unless appropriate fees are paid in full within 7 days of entries being emailed or they must accompany postal entries.
2. Competitors will be admitted free only to the session in which they compete.
3. Competitors may obtain particulars of their marks after each class on the day of competition.
4. No competitor may perform the same piece in more than one class.
5. (a) all members of the choirs singing in competitions must be bona fide members of the choir on the day of entry. Choirs must consist of no less than 15 members.

(b) In the cases of school choirs, members must be on the school's rolls on the day of entry.
6. In Junior or Juvenile competition proof of age must be produced if required and competitors must be the age stated on the **1st January 2026**.
7. (a) In all solo classes there must be at least THREE entries per class to constitute a competition. In all duet classes there must be at least TWO entries to constitute a competition.

(b) Prizes will be withheld if required standard is not met.
8. All prizes including certificates of merit are awarded at the discretion of the adjudicator, whose decision is final.
9. Any protest against the infringement of the Byelaws or against a competitor, must be in writing and accompanied by a fee of £20.00 which will be returned only if the protest is upheld by the Committee whose decision shall be final.
10. (a) Competitors must provide own choice pieces and copies of music for the adjudicator clearly labelled with class details. The original piece of the music must be used by the competitor.

(b) In all grade classes the competitor must not have passed any grade higher than the one for which he/she has been entered.

(c) A competitor may enter the grade class appropriate to his/her present standard but may also compete in his/her age group.

11. All vocal music must be sung in English and to pianoforte accompaniment, except where otherwise stated. Competitors will be judged only according to such editions or arrangements and in all the keys specified.

12. All the entries for competitions are accepted subject to these Byelaws.

13. Competitors must not perform the same piece in two consecutive years.

14. It is illegal to photocopy. Warrenpoint Feis Committee will not accept Photostat copies.

15. Competitors may only play once in any class in the traditional music section. A group or trio may include not more than one substitute player who may have competed previously in the same or in any other age group.

16. In all classes competitors must perform at the stated time of class.
We regret **no exceptions** can be made to this rule.

17. **No late entries will be accepted, under any circumstances.**

18. Entries and payment will only be accepted via the website.

19. Any competitor receiving private tuition may **not** enter the Primary School classes.

(a) Competitors are urged to avail themselves of the service of the official accompanist.

(b) Photocopies of music, clearly labelled with class details, should be presented in book form only. Neither loose single pages nor sheets held together by a single staple will be accepted by the accompanist.

(c) Competitors in classes requiring copies of music to be sent to the official accompanist must ensure that the copies are sent to **Mr Danny O'Neill.**

EXCERPTS FROM MUSICALS: It is normally permissible to perform excerpts from musical plays with a licence from the Performing Right Society Ltd., provided that:

- The excerpt does not exceed 20 minutes
- It is not a complete act of the musical play
- It does not constitute a potted version of the musical play
- It is performed without any change to either music or lyrics and using only the published or authorised musical arrangements and character representation or special lighting which gives a visual impression or other portrayal of the writer's original conception of the work from which the excerpt is taken.
- All performances using music from shows in current production are subject to Copyright Law. Entries are accepted by the Committee on the basis that any appropriate copyright permission has been obtained.
